

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium Report 2018-19

Purpose

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

How it was used in 2018-19

The school received c£1600 in 2018-9. This was used to:

- Partially fund salaries for the Year 7 Nurture Groups (English, humanities and maths)

The impact of this funding

- Numbers of students in Nurture Group with reading and/or spelling age of less than 10 halved with some students making significant progress of over 18 months in a calendar year.
- Students have made progress with numeracy.

How this funding will be used in 2018-9

The school is expecting to receive c £16,000 in 2019-20 This will be used to continue to fund the Year 7 nurture groups to support literacy and numeracy including a paying part of the salary of a specialist primary teacher and learning mentor.
