

## ***Gryphon KS3 Homework Overview – Years 7-9***

| <b>Subject</b>                      | <b>Homework Expectations</b>                                                                                                                                                                                                                             |
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| <a href="#">Art</a>                 | Students will be set one homework per half term (drawing, material collection or literacy tasks). All homework will be set via Teams.                                                                                                                    |
| <a href="#">Computing</a>           | Students will be set one piece of homework per half term for Computing in KS3. This homework will include quizzes, independent research tasks, and revision tasks for assessments such as learning key vocabulary. All homework will be set via Teams.   |
| <a href="#">Creative Design</a>     | Students will be set three items of homework per unit / project for Creative Design in KS3. This homework might include elements such as drawing, literacy and design development. All homework will be set via Teams.                                   |
| <a href="#">Drama</a>               | Students will be set one piece of homework per term for Drama in KS3. This homework will include worksheets based on topics we are focusing on, creation of posters/ presentations, quizzes, independent research tasks, and learning lines.             |
| <a href="#">English</a>             | Students will be set a Forms vocabulary learning assessment once per unit and optional creative homework choices. Reading for pleasure is ongoing, using Track My Read to regularly log how much and what they are reading.                              |
| <a href="#">Food &amp; Catering</a> | Homework for KS3 is to independently weigh out their ingredients at home prior to the practical cooking lessons.                                                                                                                                         |
| <a href="#">French</a>              | Students will be set homework fortnightly from a variety of sources such as vocabulary learning, Seneca, printed worksheets, Quizlet, Blooket, specific cultural projects.                                                                               |
| <a href="#">Geography</a>           | Students will be set a choice of tasks A & B for each unit each half term. This will take the form of revision materials, model making, long written formats and creative data representations. Full details will be submitted each half term via TEAMS. |

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| <u><a href="#">German</a></u>              | Students will be set homework fortnightly from a variety of sources such as vocabulary learning, Seneca, printed worksheets, Quizlet, Blooket, specific cultural projects.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                |
| <u><a href="#">History</a></u>             | Students should expect a homework every fortnight. This will take a wide variety of forms including writing an assessment; practicing questions; revision; designing title pages; researching a topic; preparing for presentations; reading articles; watching short documentaries. This will be set on Teams/assignment and is always designed to add to the knowledge and skills facilitated in the lessons.                                                                            |
| <u><a href="#">Maths</a></u>               | All students have thirty minutes of Sparx homework each week. They should aim to get 100% correct, using all the support both the maths department and Sparx offer. Sparx is designed to intelligently retrieve prior knowledge, testing and setting tasks that are suitable to each, individual student.                                                                                                                                                                                 |
| <u><a href="#">Music</a></u>               | Students will be set one <i>formal</i> piece of music homework per term, although teachers <i>often</i> set additional <i>informal</i> homework tasks as required each half-term over the course of the year. Most homework tasks will need to be completed on Microsoft Forms using embedded mp3 tracks. Students will usually have the <u>two-week</u> cycle to complete each music homework task. All homework tasks will be set and accessible via Teams / Assignments.               |
| <u><a href="#">Physical Education</a></u>  | Students will be set one piece of homework per term for PE in KS3. The homework will be to attend a sports related club either within school or outside of school. This is with a view to boost participation and activity levels within our community.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                   |
| <u><a href="#">Religious Education</a></u> | Students will be set one piece of homework per term for RE in KS3. This homework will include learning key vocabulary, independent research tasks, create responses tasks and revision tasks for assessments. All homework will be set via Teams.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                         |
| <u><a href="#">Science</a></u>             | <p>Students in years 7 and 8 will receive one piece of homework per topic. The homework tasks will consist of a mixture of online quizzes, creative tasks and research-based activities. All homework will be set on Teams at a point in the topic which the teacher feels is appropriate.</p> <p>Students in years 9 will receive one piece of homework per topic. These tasks will include independent revision, consolidation of knowledge, online tasks and exam style questions.</p> |
