Thank you for expressing an interest in becoming a Gryphon School Student Chaplain.

You will exemplify the Gryphon LIFE values of Leadership, Integrity, Fellowship and Exploration. Should you be successful, this will allow you the opportunity to develop organisational, communicative and leadership skills, useful on your CV/UCAS application but more importantly to aid you in your future.

Job Description

The role of a Student Chaplain might include:

- Supporting members of the school community to 'live life in its fullness'.
- Being a safe person in school, supporting students make friends and develop connections in school (particularly with Year 7 pupils)
- Represent the school, supporting work in the community and establish a charity focus to support people in the wider world.
- Help students explore spirituality and faith.
- Be good listeners, to support fellow pupils who ask for help, and to encourage them to speak to an adult who can more fully support their emotional and spiritual health and well-being.
- support reflective spaces and opportunities for creative prayer throughout the life of the school, developing opportunities for moments for stillness and reflection including helping lead some Acts of Worship.
- Helping students recognise and respect the diversity of the different cultures represented in the school and wider community.
- Meet with the school Chaplain on a regular basis with the other Student Chaplains for training, support and an opportunity for reflection.

As this is a new role in school you will help to shape the role during this year.

What's in it for you?

Successful selection in becoming a Student Chaplain will benefit you in a variety of ways:

- You will gain experience in a leadership role, learning to take on responsibility and manage expectations that are placed on you.
- The leadership skills that you develop within the role will look favourably on your CV/UCAS application forms.
- You will be able to work with different students and staff across the school.
